DATA SHARING WITH SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

Young Somerset work with Somerset County Council to ensure that young people are supported to improve their emotional wellbeing, mental health, and to enable them to access youth work that develops their skills and accreditation to support positive engagement in the community, and to improve their future employability.

Young Somerset will share with Somerset County Council high level information when a young person or child accesses our services. This information is listed below:

- Child's name
- Child DOB
- Parent Name
- Parent DOB
- Address
- Post code
- Referral criteria
- Start date of support
- End date of support
- Service supported
- Email address of Young Somerset Lead Professional

This sharing will enable Somerset County Council and other professionals to understand the support a young person is in receipt of and ensure that this is taken into account when providing their service.

Purpose for processing

To provide a service to young people to improve their wellbeing, engagement in the community, and future employability.

Legal basis for processing

Data Sharing

The personal data provided will be shared with Somerset County Council to support the young person, providing professionals with a full picture of the support being provided.

This onward sharing is being carried out under the Digital Economy Act public service delivery.

Somerset County Council will provide this information to other vetted professionals such as School Designated Safeguarding Leads to ensure that they are aware of the support that young people are receiving and to help provide services that are joined up, and improve their physical and mental wellbeing.

Transfers abroad

No data will be transferred abroad

Data Retention

We keep personal data for as long as we need to provide our services, comply with the law, and for other legitimate reasons. Young Somerset will not hold your personal data for longer than is necessary (for children this is up to age 25) for the above purposes.

Your Rights

You have the right to ask Young Somerset for a copy of your data, the right to rectify or erase your personal data, and the right to object to processing.

However these rights are only applicable if Young Somerset has no other legal obligation concerning that data. You also have the right to complain to the regulator, https://ico.org.uk/
